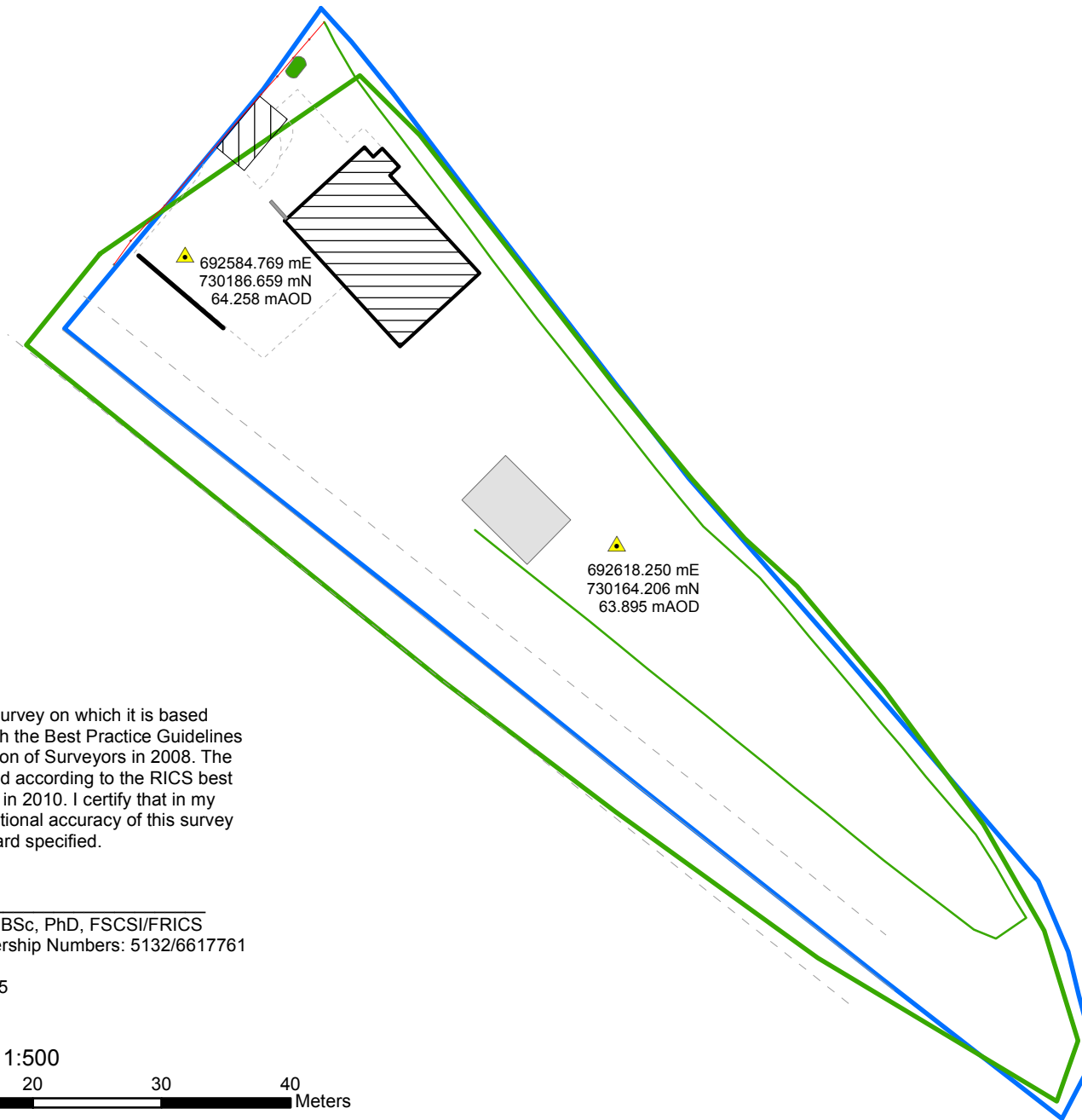
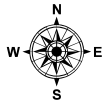

















Boundary Survey for first registration in Land Registry
